The Coalition of Labor Union Women needs your help with an important project called Working Women ROCC! (Reaching Out against Cervical Cancer).

The project is a collaboration between the Coalition of Labor Union Women (CLUW) and the Academy for Educational Development (AED) and is funded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. The project aims to reduce cervical cancer rates and disparities among working women.
