

CWA is Bargaining with AT&T Mobility in District 3:

The Contract Expires on April 16th!

Bargaining is tough. The District 3 CWA bargaining team has been sitting across the table from AT&T Mobility management since March 29th. As they have with other bargaining over the last few years, AT&T is refusing to recognize the contributions its workers have made to the success of their business. While CEO Stephenson increased his compensation last year to \$20.2 million, AT&T continues to force Mobility workers to pay increased costs for health care while refusing to pay its employees what we need and deserve.

Decades of bargaining with AT&T have taught us that the only thing that will move them is seeing that **YOU** will do whatever is necessary to support each other.

Get involved! The CWA has a history of wearing **RED** as a show of support and solidarity. We understand there are restrictions in what you can wear to work, but we need you to show management you support your brothers and sisters in District 3.
