To date AT&T has been uncooperative on retiree health care. The Local 21 bargaining committee has raised the issue but is being met with the same stone cold refusal from AT&T as the CWA. **In order to remind AT&T we are still involved in protecting our benefits I am asking retirees to return to the informational picket lines starting Wednesday July 8th. Informational picketing will be at the same locations and times as before and continue every Wednesday until further notice.**

In an on going effort to alert the public to AT&T's greedy plans, the internal organizing committee is leafleting public events. This week volunteers are leafleting the Taste of Chicago on Thursday and Friday promoting www.attgreed.com. As you can imagine they could use some help. In a continuing effort to turn up the heat, we are asking retirees to send a letter to your State Representatives and Senators about AT&T's greed.
