

AT&T FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The AT&T Foundation Scholarship Program traditionally awards 630 new scholarships each year. Awards are made available to qualifying children and stepchildren of actively employed employees of AT&T Inc. and its participating U.S. subsidiaries. Last year scholarships were awarded totaling over \$1,500,000. Awards may be used for tuition, books, supplies, and room and board expenses. Students may pursue any major they desire.

The scholarships are awarded for one full academic year. The program is not renewable; however, students may reapply to the scholarship program each year as long as they meet the eligibility requirements.

The eligibility criteria are:

- Be 25 years or younger as of February 15, 2011.
- Be students planning to enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study at a two or four-year U.S. college for the entire 2011-2012 academic year.
- Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Children of officers or senior managers are not eligible.

The scholarship amounts are:

- \$2,500 scholarship to attend a four-year college
- \$1,500 scholarship to attend a two-year college
- \$2,000 one-time honorarium to attend a military academy

Awards are highly competitive. Selection is based on:

- Academic performance
- Participation in school and community activities
- Leadership and office positions held
- Special awards and honors received
- Work history
- Personal statement of goals and aspirations

The program is administered by **Scholarship Management Services**, a division of **Scholarship America**, a national nonprofit, educational support and student aid service organization. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, gender, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability, genetic information, marital status, citizenship status, military status, veteran status, national origin, or any other characteristic protected by federal, state, or local laws.

UNCF/AT&T Foundation Scholarship Program

Application Available November 1, 2010

Eligibility Criteria:

Applicants for the UNCF/AT&T Foundation Scholarship Program must meet the following requirements.

1. Applicants must be children or stepchildren, of a full-time actively employed employee* of AT&T Inc. or its U.S. subsidiaries.
2. Applicant must be a high school senior or an undergraduate student (two- or four-year college or university).
3. Applicants must be 25 years old or younger as of February 15, 2011.
4. Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
5. Children and step children of senior managers (and officers) are not eligible.
6. Applicants must be of African American descent.

**Employee must have been employed for a minimum of at least one year as of February 15, 2011.*

Award to selected applicants will be granted as follows:

- Awards of \$2,500 to attend a four-year college or university.
- Awards of \$1,500 to attend a two-year college.
