Negotiations continued in informal discussions on Wednesday. While we have made progress over the past few weeks, there are still important issues unresolved, including health care (for both actives and retirees), wages, pensions, Prem Tech, datacomm, leveraged Service Rep and more.

There will need to be progress on these issues to reach agreement on a contract. Our committee has clearly explained to AT&T what it will take to get this done and we are prepared to negotiate round the clock to get there.
