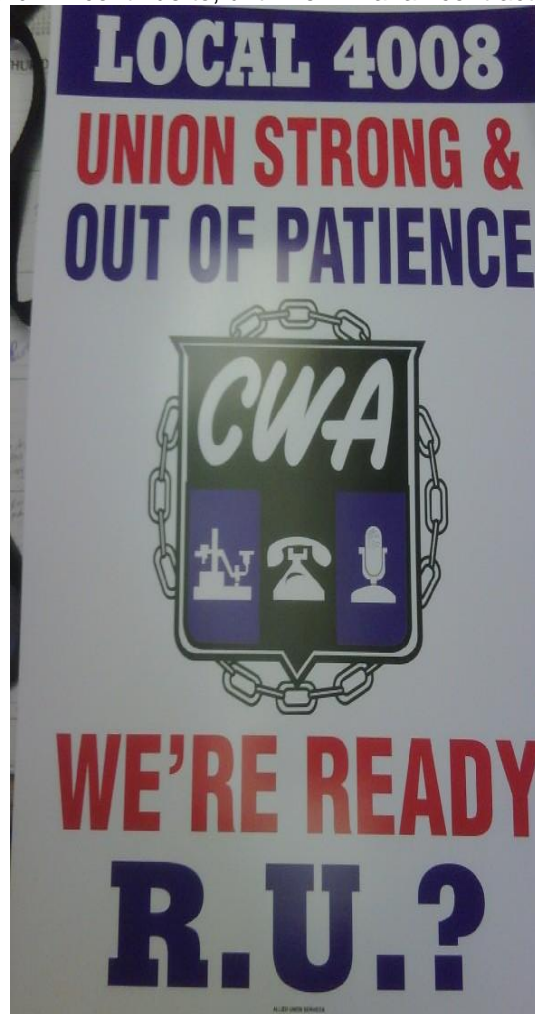


**CWA D4 AT&T Midwest Bargaining Report #69**

While we have made a lot of progress in recent weeks, AT&T seems unwilling, or perhaps even afraid, to take the next logical steps forward. We remain ready and willing to bargain round the clock on any and all issues. Of course, we can't bargain with ourselves. If discussions get back on track today, we are willing to keep working day and night through the weekend. If there are developments this weekend, we will send out our bargaining reports.
