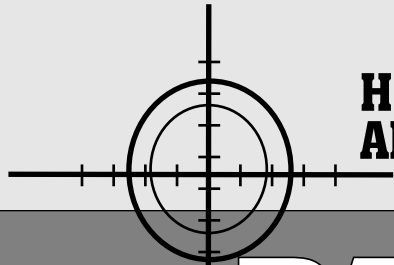

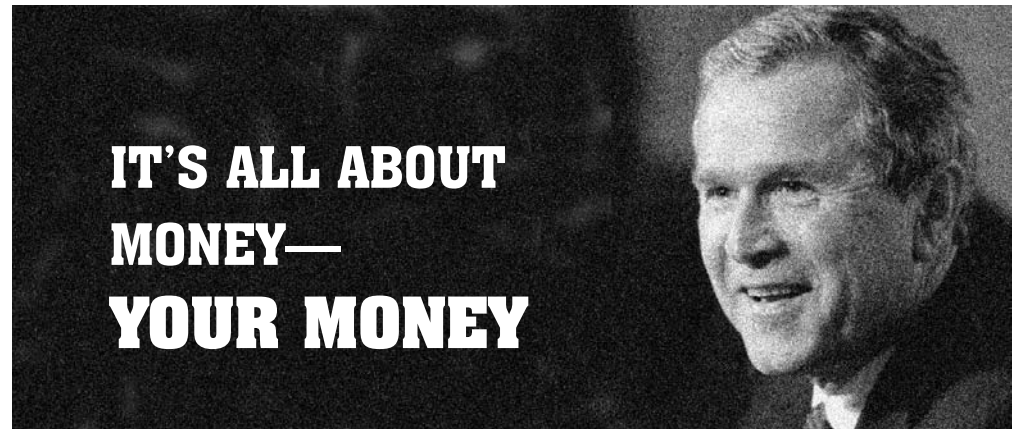

- Bush has eliminated overtime pay for up to 6 million workers.
