On Thursday, Aug. 7, the home of the Chicago Bears will host the Democratic candidates in the AFL-CIO Presidential Candidates Forum.

The venue was changed to Soldier Field to accommodate the more than 15,000 union members who are expected to attend. We wanted to make sure as many working men and women as possible could make the event.

The audience must be seated by 5:30 p.m., but security screening takes time. Be sure to get there early; doors open at 4 p.m. The forum, hosted by MSNBC's Keith Olbermann, will run from 6-8 p.m.

Due to federal election law, only AFL-CIO union members and their families may attend the forum, but it will be broadcast live in full for the public on MSNBC. You also can listen to the debate on XM Satellite Radio.
