

McCain Wants Harley Riders' Votes



...but Won't Protect Harley Workers' Jobs.

McCain Opposed a Proposal Requiring Secret Service to Buy American-Made Motorcycles. Saying he was “disappointed” with the proposal and that “I firmly object to all ‘Buy America’ restrictions,” McCain opposed requiring the Secret Service to purchase American-made motorcycles. (Congressional Record, 7/14/05)

McCain Sponsored Efforts to Waive ‘Buy American’ Laws.

- McCain sponsored an amendment to allow the secretary of defense to waive “Buy American” laws for defense systems, placing our defense manufacturing industry and jobs in jeopardy.
- He also proposed and voted for exempting defense goods from six European countries from “Buy American” requirements. Traditionally, such rules have required most military equipment and defense systems to be manufactured in the United States. (McCain Amdt. No. 3461 to S.Amdt. 3197 to S. 2400, Vote 135, 6/22/04; McCain Amdt. No. 783 to S. 1050, Vote 191, 5/21/03)

McCain Supports Tax Breaks for Companies That Send Jobs Overseas. McCain voted to protect tax breaks for companies that ship jobs overseas. (S. 1637, Vote 83, 5/5/04)

McCain ‘Would Negotiate a Free Trade Agreement with Almost Any Country’ and Thinks ‘NAFTA Was a Good Idea.’
